**A. Your qualification for CSF membership this semester is based on these guidelines:**

- You must earn a *minimum of 10 points* from **last semester's** grades
  - 4 points (at least) must be from LIST I). (It is possible for all your points to be earned from classes on List I)
  - 3 or more points may be from LIST II
  - The remaining 3 or more points may come from LIST III
- You must use *no more than 5 courses* to qualify
- NO CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teacher assisting, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis
- CSF points are granted as follows"
  - a grade of A = 3 CSF points
  - a grade of B = 1 CSF point
  - One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB, or Honors course, *up to a maximum of two such points per semester*
  - a grade of C = 0 CSF points

**You are DISQUALIFIED if you earned a grade of D or F – even if the low grade was in a course that is not on one of the three lists**

**B. Also remember:**

- Each semester's membership is based on course work in the *previous* semester. **Summer school may not count towards CSF**
- You must reapply *each* semester
- Courses you may use are attached. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III

**C. List the courses you are using to qualify in the proper location below.** Consult LISTS on the back of your letter.

Remember, all your points may be earned from list I alone. You do not need courses from List II or III to qualify, but you may use courses from List II or III if necessary to total 10 points.
